TEACHERS ARE COOL

As far as the kindergarten department is concerned, classes are held through videos sent in WhatsApp. Sessions usually 15-20 minutes long and do are not go beyond 30 minutes. Topics from songs and to numbers and alphabets are covered rhymes and are done with the sole purpose of keeping the children updated and engaged. When it comes to online classes, we cannot expect to reap the fruits of live classes. In school, teachers put in their utmost effort and parents need only guide them. But when it comes to virtual classes, parents are the ones that have to put in most of the effort. Children often neglect their work and procrastinate as their work is checked by anyone. And online classes do not not have the same impact that live classes do. Reciprocation and communication is the key to the development of a child and it is not possible when it comes to online teaching. We usually talk about problems children face at home and they can talk to us freely in the school premises. The same is not possible when it comes to virtual meetings. Liveliness is completely missed and the process of virtual teaching is artificial and cannot be compared to the effects produced in a classroom.



When the subject of Social science is brought for-ward, video classes have been more helpful in information. delivering Classes are conducted through recorded videos and primary students do not have the patience to listen for a long time which is why I have limited my teaching to 2 or 3 videos that 4-5 minutes long. Virtual classes are comfortare able when it comes to eliminating distractions that occur in the classroom. But the reactions of students are unknown due to which we don't know if they can understand what is taught. We have to speak slowly and improvise due to which interaction is not possible. One of the main things necessary to cope with virtual learning is that parents have to be a bridge between the students and the teachers. They should monitor the children and should spend time with them in learning. At first, the process was interesting but if we don't bring new and fresh methods the students they might become bored. As far to as primary classes are concerned, completing the portions will be quite comfortable, but it is the middle and high school classes that might have overloading of portions. Until the end of the pandemic, this solution might be the way to go, but when we talk about the long run, the long-established way is better.

If we were to choose between virtual or interactive classes, I would prefer the latter. When we teach virtual classes we don't get feedback and don't know if the students understand. In video classes, we have to ask questions and answer the same which is quite tough as it eliminates the process of interaction. Recorded videos pose these setbacks. Online classes might be an even more effective alternative. Parents and students can be educated to make use of facilities such as Cisco WebEx, Google Meet, etc. Board teaching is better than using PPTs but we have to adapt to the situation. Some of my students strongly feel that classroom teaching will have a better reach than the virtual one. Language and math are the subjects that will find it difficult to take the portions forward. We have to come to terms with the fact that this might be the new normal. The virtual model of teaching can be an effective supplement but it cannot be a substitute for the traditional method of teaching. ucation. Planning and giving concise content is the key to keeping the students engaged as well as making sure they learn something. Through online teaching, teachers become well equipped with techintelligence paving the way for nological more effective communication with the students. It is also up to the students to harness facilities positively to receive the true benefits. The cost of travelling, travel time and distractions are some of the things we can evade when it comes to virtual learning. Students can create their environments for learning and can devote complete attention to the conce when they are in the comfort of their homes. When online tests are conducted, it is an easier way to assess the understanding of a concept. Everything has its pros and cons. If students understand the effort of the parents and teachers and cooperate in the process they are benefitted. It is not easy for the teachers to complete their portions, but as of now, the main focus is to make sure that the students understand and do not lose their academic touch. Online studies are ideal for learning non-collegiate activities, but when it comes to subject matter nothing can compared with the effectiveness of live classes.
